



The Mountain Dell staff would like to invite you to join the 2008 men's association. League play is every Thursday beginning May 1st. Tee times are available to our members from 9:00 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. These times will be available for the first week of play beginning Tuesday April 29th at 7:00 a.m. After week 1 tee times will be available 1 week ahead of time in the pro shop.

Fees will remain the same in 2008. They are \$20.00 to join and \$7.00 a week for the pay offs. The money will be disbursed as followed: \$5.00 (gross and net pay off) \$0.75 (gross skins) \$0.75 (net skins) **\$0.50 (closest to the pin contests)**. Skins and closest to the pin winnings may be used towards green fees at Mountain Dell only. Scores and results will be posted as early as Friday and no later then Monday. You can find these results on the website (mountaindellmens.com) or in the foyer next to the restrooms.

Player of the Year points will be awarded weekly. These points are earned by the low 15 gross scores. Eight man teams are filled based on the top point winners and captain picks. We will again field two regular teams and one senior team (50+ in age). If you are interested in participating please let us know asap. The club championship will be the last chance to earn points for player of the year. Points will be awarded for the first round scores, second round scores, and double points for the total championship score. Anyone in the hunt can make a huge push by playing well in the club championship.

The Mountain Dell Club Championship is scheduled for Thursday September 4th (round 1) and Saturday September 6th (round 2). Because of the increased participation in 2007 we now have enough players to justify a shotgun start for the second round. Start time will be 8:00 a.m. so please plan ahead and mark it on you calendar. At the completion of round 2 lunch and drinks will be served during an awards banquet. We are hoping to fund the lunch and banquet with sponsorship money. We are looking for anyone interested in sponsoring the Mountain Dell Men's Association for advertising in return. We will have a large banner made with the sponsor's logos on it and hang the banner on the driving range net where anyone playing can't miss it. This will be inexpensive advertising and great marketing for anyone interested. Logos will also be seen on the Mountain Dell Men's Association website. For those of you that weren't able to participate in the 2007 club championship, please be advised that the extra added money into the purse makes the payouts extremely lucrative. The more sponsorship money we can raise the more we can payout in this incredible event.

After 3 rounds players will have a league handicap. Your UGA handicap has no influence on your league handicap. Handicaps are updated weekly and are solely based on league scores. This eliminates sandbagging and everyone should win throughout the year. Players are responsible to post scores into the UGA computer at your discretion we do not post scores for you.
